

MMHEC and JODER ARABIAN RANCH DOG POLICY

Boarders and leasers are welcome to bring dogs to the ranch with the following caveats. (Note that Ham and Bear, as ranch staff dogs, are excepted from this rule)

1. NO dogs are allowed in the Pat Joder-Cox driveway, yards, gardens, patios, and the hillside on the east and south sides of her house.
2. NO dogs are permitted in any of the arenas, in any horse pens, or in the round pens.
3. Dogs must be on a leash in the tacking areas, but please avoid leaving your dog tied up on the patio in front of the lounge.
4. Dogs may be tied on a leash in the tree area below/east of the indoor arena or to the east post in the hay barn. Please be sure your dog has water available at all times.
5. Dogs may go on the trail with horse and owner. Please walk your horse and dog approximately 100 feet away from the main barn area before unleashing your dog and mounting your horse.
6. Dogs must be on voice command on the trail.
7. Dogs may not chase the wildlife or go on private land surrounding the ranch.
8. Dogs must be on leash at all times on Boulder County and City Open Space. Be sure you don't ride onto the Open Space with your dog loose.
9. Never leave your dog in the car during the summer.
10. Please clean up after your dog. Plastic bags can be found behind the door in the lounge.
11. Please leave your dog at home if he or she habitually engages in excessive barking.
